

# Limmel Neighbourhood Protocol

The Limmel neighbourhood should be a pleasant place for everyone to live. To promote the quality of life in Limmel for all residents, the following rules apply:

## 1. Waste and clean living environment:

- Use the bin bags prescribed by the municipality. Close them properly and put them outside at the prescribed times, not before. Information about the times can be found on the waste calendar distributed door-to-door by the municipality and on the website of the Municipality of Maastricht. This also applies to organic waste bins/buckets.
- Prevent litter (including discarded plastic cups, beer bottles, and shopping trolleys/baskets).
- Contribute to a clean living environment.

## 2. Bicycles:

- Park bicycles in the back garden or storage room. If these are not available, bicycles may be parked on the pavement or in designated bicycle parking areas. Please ensure that pedestrians and wheelchair users are not inconvenienced.
- Adhere to the general rules for a pleasant living environment.

## 3. Peace and privacy:

- Ensure that you do not cause any nuisance to local residents. In general, refrain from behaviour that, according to common standards, causes nuisance to other residents, such as shouting, singing, vomiting and urinating in the street.
- Respect the peace and privacy of neighbours when they are in their gardens. This also includes sitting on windowsills with the windows open.
- If a party is occasionally planned in a home, neighbours must be notified in good time (at least one day in advance), stating the end time of the party.
- Ensure that neighbours have contact details (in the case of student houses, ensure that a house representative is appointed to maintain contact with neighbours).
- Respect each other's property (including front gardens).
- You are responsible for the behaviour of your visitors/guests.



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#### 4. Noise pollution:

- Avoid playing music while windows and doors are open.
- Play music at an acceptable volume.
- Between 10 p.m. and 7:30 a.m., it is expected to be completely quiet.
- Make sure that after 10 p.m. you do not stand outside on the street or in front of a building chatting, or chat indoors with the windows open.
- After 10 p.m., walk quietly through the streets (i.e. no singing or shouting).
- The sleep of local residents must be respected.

#### 5. Use of alcohol and drugs:

- The consumption of alcoholic beverages and drugs in public spaces is prohibited in Limmel. This means no alcohol or drugs on the streets or in the park.

#### 6. Communication:

- If you have any complaints, first discuss them with each other in a civilised manner. Show respect for each other and your differences.

### Hotel Management School Maastricht

To promote the quality of life in Limmel for all residents, we, as the Hotel Management School Maastricht, contribute to this by:

- During the introduction of new students (boot camp), familiarising students with the values of the HMSM and the desired behaviour that goes with them.
- Organising a Boostcamp activity in which first-year students and residents of Limmel engage in conversation about the quality of life in the neighbourhood.
- Participating in consultations between the Municipality, Amphitryon and the Neighbourhood Network.
- Holding discussions with student houses that cause nuisance.
- Support activities that promote quality of life.

### SV Amphitryon

The Limmel neighbourhood should be a pleasant place for everyone to live. Members, prospective members, former members and guests must adhere to the neighbourhood protocol. The Board will monitor compliance with the various points of attention. Violators may be sanctioned by the Board in accordance with the Sanctions Regulations in force at Amphitryon. In order to promote the quality of life in Limmel for all residents, the following rules of conduct apply:

#### ***Neighbourhood Protocol Times***

- The protocol applies every day, with particular attention to the period between 10 p.m. and 7.30 a.m.



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### **Arrival and departure Clubhouse or events**

- Upon arrival, please use Bethlehemweg. Upon departure, please use Jeruzalemweg. If you wish to come to our club by taxi, please also have the taxi take Jeruzalemweg.
- Please observe complete silence in Limmel upon arrival and departure. The night's rest of local residents must be respected at all times.
- Urinating, vomiting, causing damage or any other nuisance is of course strictly prohibited.
- When you leave, please leave your glasses or cups at the club. Also, when you come to the club, please leave your glasses or cups at home.
- SV Amphitryon considers the social safety of its members to be of paramount importance. As the Board, we would therefore like to urge you not to cycle home alone. Cycle home with others as much as possible, and if someone asks you to cycle with them, please do so.

### **SV Amphitryon actions**

- The Amphitryon Board will, if necessary, hold discussions with both the chairpersons of the debating societies and the management of the Hotel Management School Maastricht. Personal contact, active checks and control of disruptive student traffic when students leave the club.
- Participate in consultations between the Municipality, HMSM and the Neighbourhood Network.
- Participate in the HMSM Boostcamp.
- Timely reporting of events and checks by the neighbourhood.
- The rules from the neighbourhood protocol are actively distributed among the members and are clearly visible in the clubhouse.
- The current Board introduces the new Board to the Neighbourhood Network.



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
